The Adaptive Brain in a Fast-Evolving World

What are the Brain Innovation Days?

The concept of the Brain Innovation Days, led by the European Brain Council, is to enhance multi-stakeholder engagement in the brain ecosystem to foster dialogue, exchange knowledge, accelerate investment in research and innovation, facilitate business development and showcase on-going work.

At some point of their lives, one in three Europeans will live with a brain disease – neurological and mental alike. It is estimated that brain disorders account for up to 45% of total healthcare budgets. Despite this high prevalence of brain disorders in Europe, a wide range of mental and neurological conditions has currently no disease-modifying treatment or cure. Compared to other disease areas, multiple factors hinder the pace of innovation in this field, including the complexity of the brain itself. Research in the field is disproportionately underfunded compared to other disease areas and, as a result, brain treatments remain insufficient. It is critical that the scientific, patient, stakeholder and policy community come together and exchange on the state of play.

The first Brain Innovation Days launched virtually during the COVID-19 pandemic in 2020, kicking off one full year of a packed brain innovation agenda, building up to the 1st on-site event in 2021. Five years later, the 5th edition of the Brain Innovation Days took place on **15-16 October 2025** in Brussels (Belgium) under the overarching theme “**The Adaptive Brain in a Fast-Evolving World**”. The two jam-packed days of high-level brain innovation brought together more than 80 speakers and more than 30 sessions, including inspiring Brain Talks and panel discussions, impressive innovation showcases, and last but not least, an abundance of networking opportunities.





Engaging the entire brain community

An idea born out of exchange between leading organisations in brain research and brain-related start-ups, and the need to better integrate the various brain communities in the wider ecosystem.



Accelerating Innovation

Where leaders in their own fields can meet to exchange knowledge, foster collaboration, connect the dots within the wider brain innovation community, inspire policy reform and prioritisation, and potentiate/accelerate investment and business opportunities.


